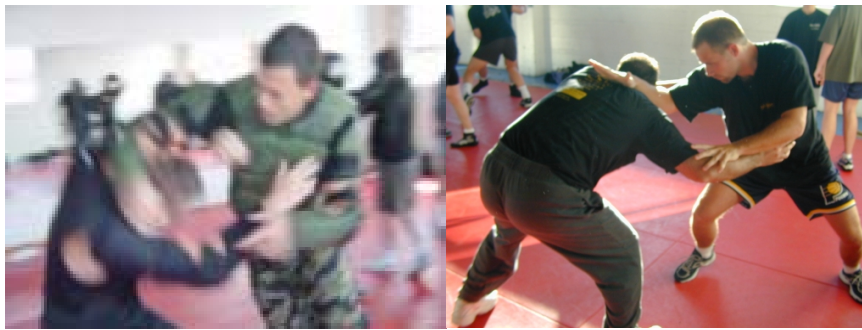

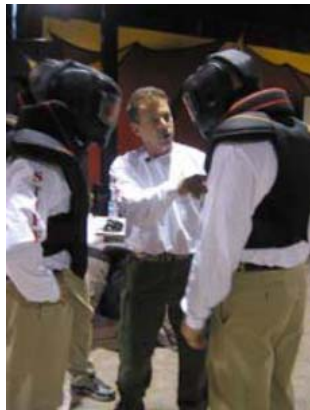

HOW OFTEN IS THE TRAINING HELD?

The PDR INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATION SESSION is held twice a year, typically in the fall & spring. It is held over a three-day period at locations around the world. Aside from USA, we have expanded the program into Europe. The program comes complete with extensive training sessions, PowerPoint presentations, training manuals, handouts, lesson templates and more. Technical and biomechanical dissection of the S.P.E.A.R. System and other components of our renowned courses are shared. During the session there is an evaluation and then post session requirements to complete your certification. Having said that, of course someone can fail to graduate, but only if they fail to prepare and/or participate. Remember, the research is behaviorally based, which means it integrates with any sound system. We have instructors from hard karate styles to JKD and Krav Maga. There are point fighters and MMA fighters in the PDR program and we even have several DT & combative instructors. It's that dynamic. It fills holes, creates training as well as teaching opportunities and adds new dimensions to any curriculum.
